FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners

I haven't written much about my trip to El Salvador since I returned. In many ways, I am still processing the experience. I enjoyed it more than my visit to Honduras. There was a better balance of language, culture and priestly ministry. This weekend, I will visit Saint John's in Clinton to assist with Father Jaime Hernandez with the Mass in Spanish. Only upon my arrival in El Salvador did I realized that I was living in the town in which Father Jaime grew up. As a young child, Jaime came with him family to the United States as refugees. Running through the fields, he stepped on a landmine and lost his leg below the knee. His recuperation was successful because he came to the United States. Now, he is giving back as a priest and working very hard to serve the people of Clinton. I'm looking forward to sharing in his ministry as I need to keep practicing the language. Some have asked me if we will start a ministry to Spanish speaking people here at Holy Family. I'm certainly open to it and need a good group with the skills to lay the foundation. "If the Lord does not build the house, in vain do the builders labor." One thing that brings Catholics from around the world together is the gift of celebration! While we are reminded of the challenges and the struggles, the gift of life and the gift of faith brings us to celebrate. We share in celebrations of events that took place before we were around. We share in celebrations of people who we don't know. It brings a smile to our face and reminds us of the blessings that we have and share with others. This is what I hope for the Anniversary Celebrations we have coming up. I've only been a part of this community for four years. Others much longer and others shorter. But we come together to share the gift of faith and the gift of community. We come together to pass on a legacy to the next generation; a legacy that reminds them that our faith in Jesus Christ means something, our participation in the Church means something, our community made of diverse groups of people means something. As we celebrate, we ask ourselves, what ways are we passing on hope and faith? We pray for members of our community that have died and those that are not with us anymore for a myriad of reasons. We pray for those who, by God's providence, will join us in the journey that is our shared discipleship. What are you celebrating?
