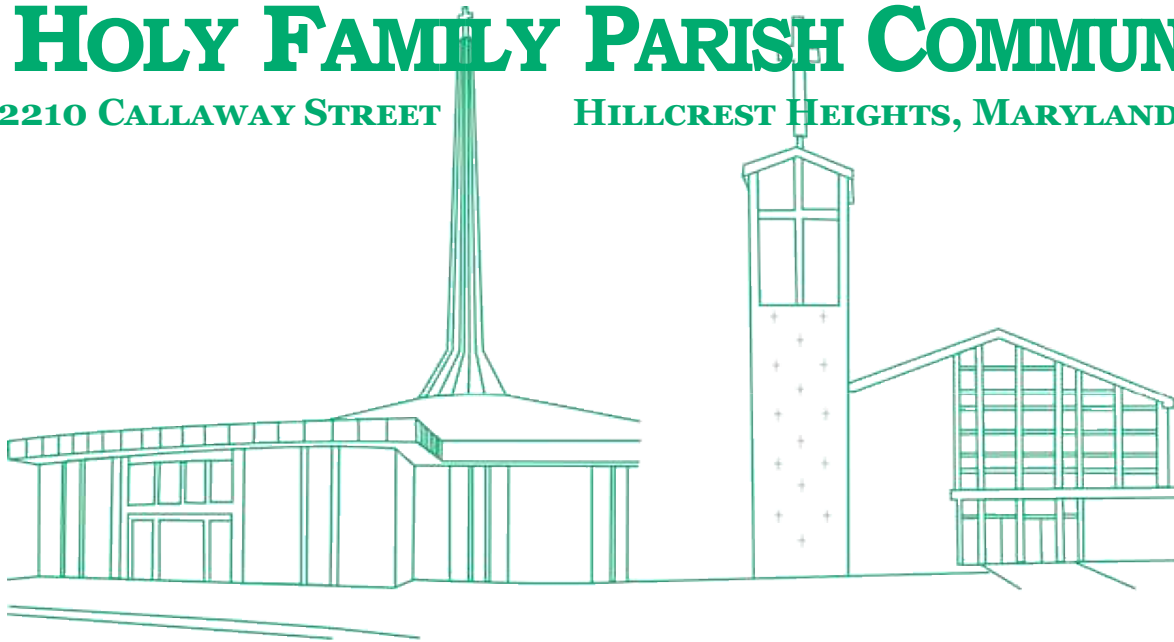

**FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR**

Dear Parishioners,

In the Book of Ezra, we hear that the people of Judah are freed from captivity and exile in Babylon. The first command that is given to them is to return to Jerusalem and to restore the Temple. "Let him go up ... and rebuild the house of the LORD" - *Ezra 1:3*. The temple was the meeting place of God and his people. What hurt the most about their exile was being far from the land promised and the temple. These were signs of God's blessing to them. Our beautiful church is a sign of God's blessing to our community. It was built by previous generations and kept up by our families. We have been good stewards to what we have received. We ourselves have a chance to contribute to the rebuilding of the House of the Lord. In our buildings, we leave a legacy behind for future generations to know the Lord.

In January, a group of parishioners began meeting to discuss the beauty and uniqueness of our Church sanctuary. We made comparisons with other churches. We discussed what adaptations and adjustments we would like to see. After making a list of items, we sent recommendations to a liturgical consultant, Gardiner Hall. Following summer discussions with the consultant, we arrived at three focus areas for Phase One Re:Build - Renewal and Beautification. The first area, presented in September, consisted of hanging of the Crucifix above the altar and the painting of the drywall areas behind the altar. The second, is presented this weekend, is a proposal for the flooring in the main aisle, around the sanctuary and sacristy. The ceramic tiles of various colors can be seen on the poster-board by the entrance to the church. Special areas, available for memorialization, will use icons to highlight the members of the Holy Family, Jesus, Mary and Joseph. Vinyl floor could be an option for the remainder of the floor not covered by these ceramic tiles. The final focus area will be the Stations of the Cross. Each one could be removed, cleaned, polished, and sealed with a simple gilding or color washing. I've reached out to the Liturgical Arts Communion of the Archdiocese of Washington for their comments about these plans. I know that I will hear from you and bring these back to our committee.

Later in October, I will present to you, ideas for memorializing these projects. Some basic funding has been set aside in our annual budget. Some has been received from donors already, memorializing their deceased loved ones. We will discuss how these projects will be supported and paid for as a parish.
