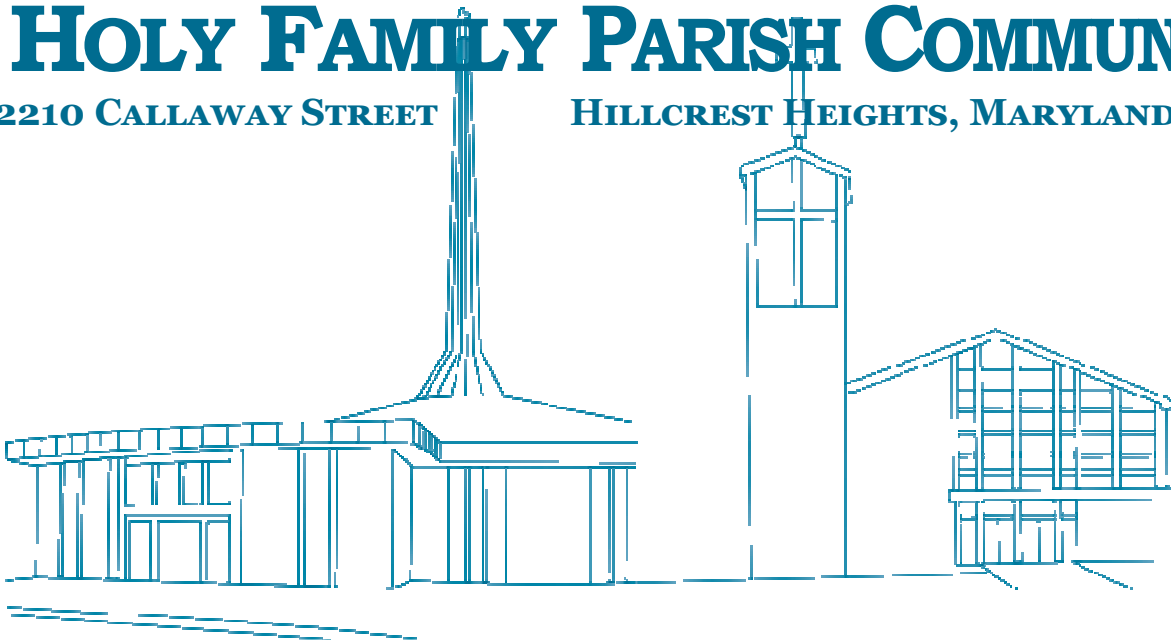

**FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR**

Dear Parishioners,

While we have passed the secular holiday of Thanksgiving, we arrive at the celebration of our Sunday Eucharist (which is the greek word for “thanksgiving”). The celebration of our Mass is the best way to give thanks to God for his goodness. There is something essential built into our Catholic lives that reminds us to be thankful. “Give thanks with a grateful heart. Give thanks to the Holy One. Give thanks because he’s given Jesus Christ, his Son.”

This weekend, as we come to the end of the liturgical year and prepare for the New Year with Advent starting next week, we can give thanks for Jesus Christ, King and Lord of the Universe. We are not always able to be thankful for some politicians who continue to create division and strife from their authority. However, when Jesus reigns in our hearts, we allow his Kingdom to reign more in our world. His is a Kingdom of Justice, Peace and Love.
