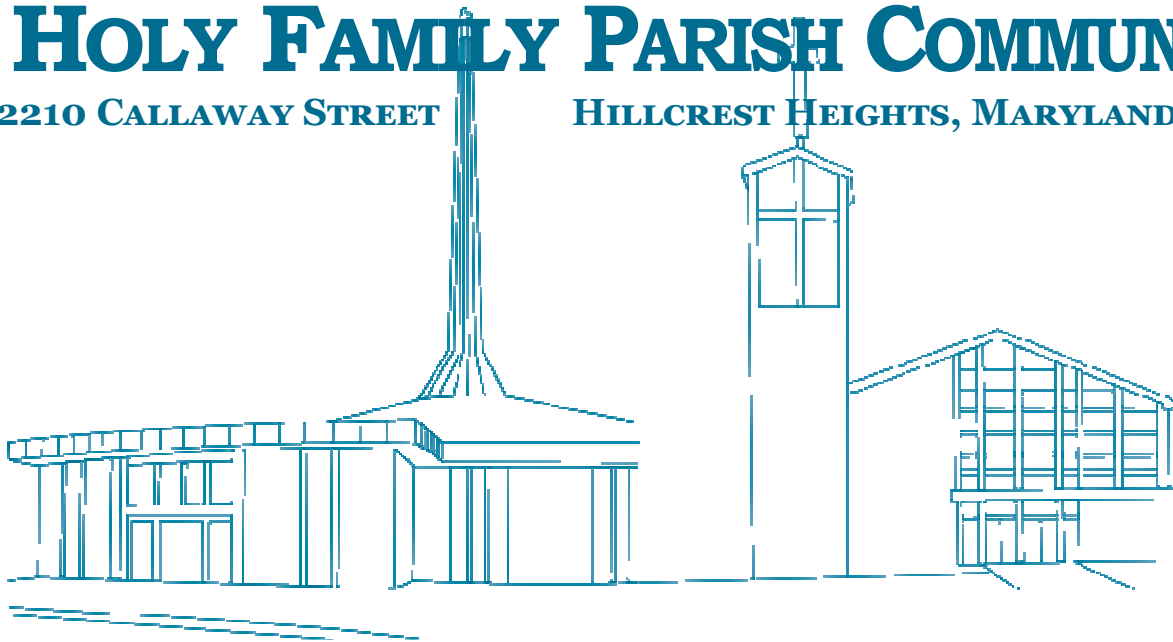

**FROM POPE FRANCIS - REJOICE AND BE GLAD**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,  
Closing the month of April, we have completed our presentations of our Ministries following each Mass. A special thanks to all who coordinated and presented. A excited welcome to those who signed up to learn more. We are still interested in what you are interested in. ICYDK is no more. Now You Know!

Arriving at the Month of May, I can think of two things that guide us - 1) The Month of Mary and 2) The Descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. In one week, we will crown our Blessed Mother during our celebration of Mother's Day. In two weeks, we will celebrate Pentecost. Mary and the Holy Spirit can not be separated. From the moment of Gabriel's greeting and Mary's "Yes," they were intimately entwined. Mary is the Spouse of the Holy Spirit.

All that Mary did and still does is based on her relationship with the Holy Spirit. She is truly the first Christina disciple because of it and the first Christian minister. While we have completed our presentations of Ministries, that was the easy part - inviting! Now we get to the follow-up and engaging, those established in their ministries and those who are newly interested. We shouldn't be timid because we have only been in the parish for a few months. Nor should we be overly directive because we have been established here for years. In the Holy Spirit, we are one! We see Mary's service and humility and we hope to establish that on her example and the Grace of God.

I invite you to prepare for Pentecost by remembering that Mary was with the Apostles to teach them about receiving the Holy Spirit during those nine days in the Upper Room. On Saturday, May 19th, at our 4 pm Vigil Mass, we will celebrate the extended Pentecost Vigil. There will be extra readings and prayers for us to contemplate the presence of the Holy Spirit leading and guiding God's Chosen People. This helps us to be aware to the presence of the Holy Spirit comforting us for mission and ministry in our community. I invite all seasoned minsters and new ministers to come and pray for the gifts of the Holy Spirit that are shared with each other to renew our parish and give us hope in God's will.
